# 3. Minutes of the last meeting

#### 8. Highways

- 8.1 <u>Highways Issues</u>: It was noted that there is a highways update in the Annual Meeting booklet. Cllr J Sams, in her role as Borough Councillor, has arranged a meeting on Friday with Steve Henson, who is overseeing the A20 Improvement Scheme, to discuss some snagging. It was noted that s106 money will be available from the Mayfield Nursery site, when the development has progressed.
